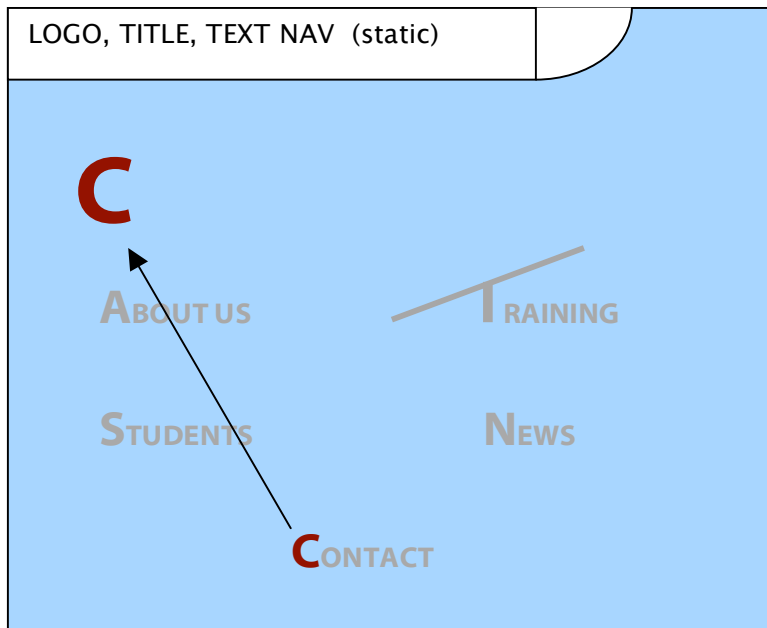
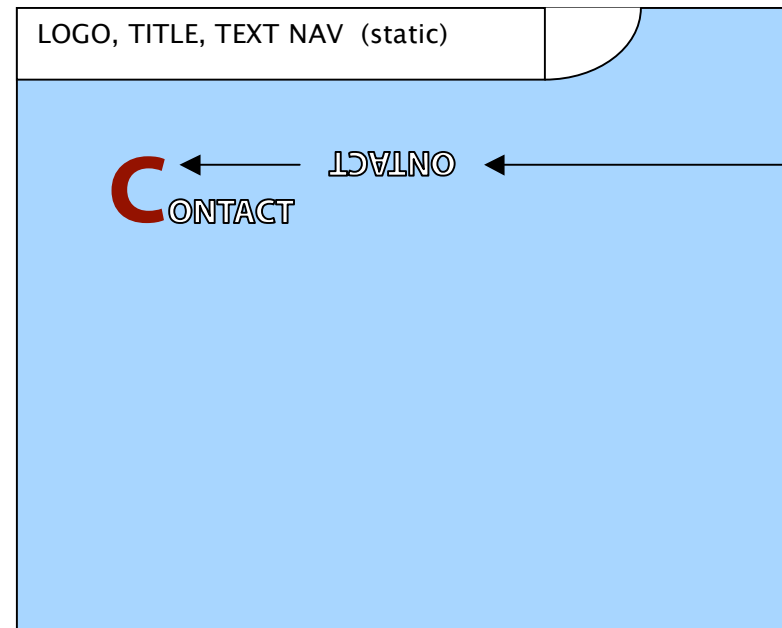


STORYBOARD FOR "CONTACT" BUTTON

Clicking on "**Contact**" causes the screen to shift to the Second Level Page Layout (see Layouts.doc). This means that other menu items fade out, as does the background image and the "**ontact**" portion of "**Contact**".

Simultaneously with this fade, the letter "**C**" in "**Contact**" enlarges. The "**C**" moves to the upper left of the screen under the logo.

Then, the "**ontact**" lettering slides in *reversed and upside down* from the RIGHT and "runs" through the top of the "**C**" (like going through a tunnel) and around and out the bottom to stop in its usual position to become the header for this section of the site.

(NOTE: I had to use special text here because Word can't do text transformations. Disregard text style in this panel.)

Immediately after the header animation, subheadings slide in from left to right, bouncing back slightly left into position.

The address info will fade in while the white panel containing the form will slide in from the right side, followed by the background image fading in at the bottom of the page.

This is approximately what the "Contact" page will look like when the animation has finished.
