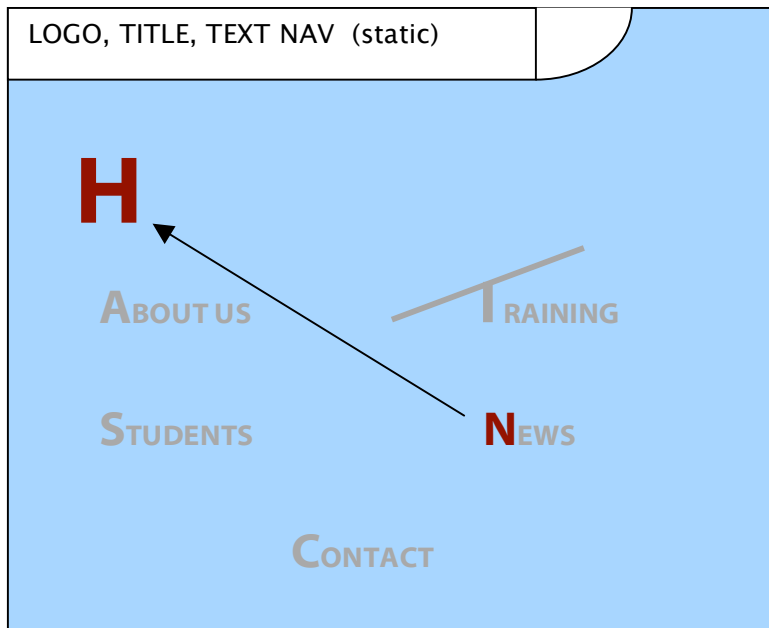
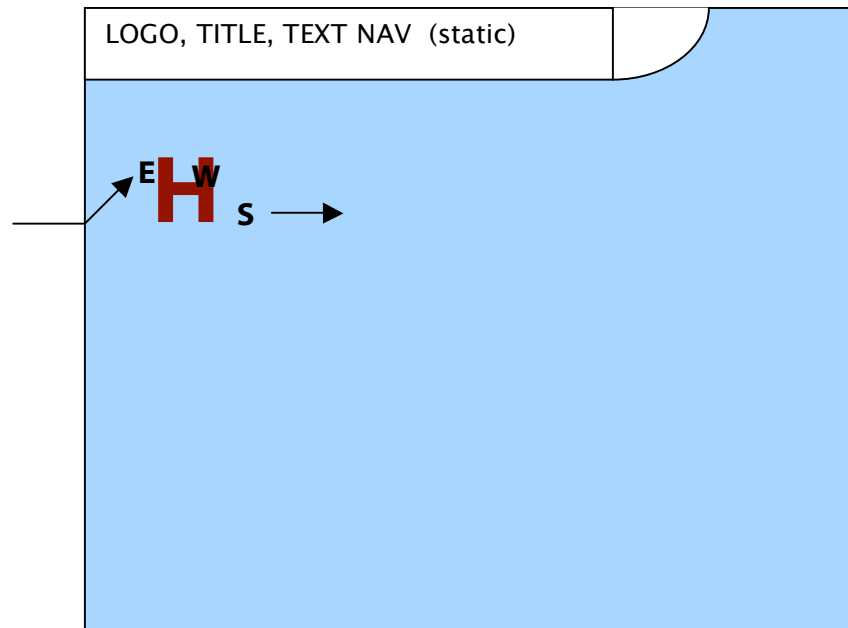


STORYBOARD FOR “NEWS” BUTTON

Clicking on “**News**” causes the screen to shift to the Second Level Page Layout (see Layouts.doc). This means that other menu items fade out, as does the background image and the “ews” portion of “**News**”.

Simultaneously with this fade, the letter “**N**” in “**News**” enlarges and moves to the upper left of the screen under the logo *and shape tweens into an “H” temporarily.*

Then, the “ews” lettering slides in from the left and “jumps” over the “**H**”, landing in the proper spot on the other side.

The “H” shape tweens back to an “N” and we have the header for this section of the site.

Immediately after the header animation finishes its tween, subheadings slide in from left to right, bouncing back slightly left into position.

The graphic / photo will fade in on the right, as will the quote at the bottom of the page.

This is approximately what the “News” page will look like when the animation has finished.
